- Basic set up and shut down of sandblast facility and equipment. Basic troubleshooting of equipment.
- Reloading of abrasives into machine hopper
- Learn and develop understanding of blasting techniques
- Learn and develop a basic understanding of differences in metal substrates
- Examination of finished parts to ensure conformance to specifications and quality control
- Maintain and conform to safe work procedures according to prescribed protocol
- Preparation of work product by masking, taping and other means to protect from abrading action
- Loading and unloading of customer work product
